Ever Increasing Faith

Have you been feeling lost and confused? You have reasons to be-your life is in turbulence, the wind is not blowing your way, and you are waiting-for the right person or the right job or the right situation to come your way-but it hasn't. Getting your needs met by turning to another for comfort or trusting in someone is temporarily satisfying, but often, it is disappointing. It is satisfying when you turn to a friend who really understands your situation and can empathize with you, but it is disappointing when you put your trust in someone and that person fails to

respond to you at a time when you need him or her. Who can you turn to at a time like this?

You turn to God knowing and believing that he has the power to change your circumstances. Others can pray with and for you, but only God can change your situation. He is the author and finisher of your faith (Hebrews 12:2). God knew you before you were born. He formed you in your mother's womb (Isaiah 44:2). He has counted all the hairs on your head (Luke 12:7). He knows the length of your days, all of your thoughts-your fears and your anxieties. He knows your past, what you are presently dealing with (Ps.139:1-10) and identifies with your pain; for he himself bore your pain when he suffered and died on Calvary for your sins and mine. But that was not the end. Jesus rose the third day, victorious over sin and death (Mark 16:6).

What a friend we have in Jesus. He is our friend in the time of our need. He is our comforter (Psalm 94:19). He listens to our cries anytime in the day or night. He is never busy or tired. In our struggles, he encourages us to have faith in him, that he will work things out in his time and for our good (Mark 11:22; Romans 8:28). He lets us know that faith moves mountains and obstacles in our lives; and that we can trust in the God in whom we serve by exercising faith in him; for He is able to do abundantly more than we can ask or think according to the power working within us (Matthew 11:20; Ephesians 3:20).

I regard this belief in him as ever increasing faith-a level of faith that allows us to stand on God's promises regardless of how intense our situations may be. We need to embrace this faith even when we realize that our circumstances may never change. Why? God has the answers to our lives. The Bible says that God is love. God loves us and is concerned about every detail of our lives (1 John 4:8-10). He is the potter and we are the clay (Isaiah 64:8). Can we tell God what to do and how to do it?
